FUNDING

FUNDING GUIDELINES:

- Application is eligible to receive funding.
- Application meets a significant and demonstrable need in the local Inala community.
- Application is based on sound research and has a strong likelihood of meeting its objectives.
- Incomplete applications will not be assessed.
- If time constraints apply to the funding, this should be noted in your Application.
- Keep a copy of your Application Form for your own records and in case of request.
