Estuary & Surf Fishing

Estuary and Surf fish 16 trips a year, six of these are interclub competitions against other fishing clubs. Three of those are fished on Moreton Island using 4x4 vehicles with the other three from boats at either Jumpinpin or Broadwater areas. The remaining 10 trips are club trips fished overnight at various locations. Fishing starts at 3.00pm on Saturday afternoons, with weigh in held at Blue Fin Clubhouse carpark at 8.00 am Sunday mornings.

No fees are charged, but participants are required to provide their own bait and tackle. Juniors ages 6 years and above are encouraged to participate, but must be accompanied by an adult.

The club has two boats available for hire to members on trips.

Boat license and suitable vehicle to tow is required. The cost of hiring a boat is \$50.00.

Freshwater Fishing

We fish at dams, weirs and waterways within a realistic distance from the Club. Those places are Maroon Dam, Moogerah Dam, Connolly Dam, Leslie Dam, Coolmunda Dam, Boondooma Dam and Bjelke Peterson Dam.

We fish 12 trips per season with 6 of those being bus trips. Freshwater is a family friendly and fun way to fish.

Deep Sea Fishing

Are you ready for the best fishing experience of your life?

Deep Sea fishing trips are held in various locations. Participants can meet at the boat or carpool at the club on the morning of departure. Deep Sea fishing is bottom fishing only, no float fishing. Charter Boats normally depart about 5.30am and return at 3.00pm. There are approx. 7 trips per year, weather permitting. The primary target species are quality table fish such as snapper, pearl perch, tusk fish and other reef species.

For \$145 you spend 10 hours on the open blue ocean bottom bashing with all your bait, tackle and drinks included.

Offshore Game Fishing

Offshore Game fishing was created to offer the complete angling adventure experience. Larger fish are specifically targeted. In summer, the primary focus is the larger pelagic species such as Marlin, Sailfish, Mahi Mahi (Dolphin Fish) Tuna and Wahoo. In winter, we target the larger bottom-feeding fish such as Amberjack, Mulloway, Kingfish and Cobia. These trips are a great opportunity to catch the fish of a lifetime in the waters right here at our doorstep. As you can see from the photos on the information board the success rates are very high.

Offshore Game Fishing does seven trips per year, weather permitting. Most trips are from the Gold Coast. Charter Boats normally depart about 5.30am and return at 3.00pm. Cost is usually \$145 per person with everything included. Participants can meet at the boat or carpool at the club on the morning of departure.
